Anne Frank's life used to be flowery teenager that went well, Anne had an older sister named Margot, Frank's family belonged to liberal Jews, and did not follow all Jewish customs and traditions. But at the time of war II his life changed they had to hide from the cruelty of Nazi Germany. From that time until the family's arrestin August 1944, Anne kept a diary she had received as a birthday present, and wrote in it regulary. After their arrest the Franks were transported to a concentration camp. On November 1, 1944, Anne and her sister died a few monts later.

II RESEARCH METHODS
